



## Continuing Education Requirements for Colorado Marriage & Family Therapists (And How to Stay on Track)

As a licensed marriage and family therapist (MFT) in the state of Colorado, it is your responsibility to adhere to continuing education requirements each period in order to renew your license. Beyond license renewal being key to you maintaining your practice, continuing education is essential to stay abreast of what is happening in your field – something your clients will always appreciate you taking seriously. ### Licensee Requirements for Colorado Marriage & Family Therapists

A Colorado MFT is required to fulfill 40 hours of continuing education in order to renew their license every two years. Not only that, but Colorado MFTs are also required to complete the professional survey and self-assessment as well as establish learning goals and a learning plan. When working toward earning the 40 hours of continuing education, each credit should be in alignment with the set learning goals and plan, though, your plan is permitted to change slightly throughout your cycle. The self-assessment can be completed using [this form](#), and the learning goals and plan can be created with [this form](#) – keep both for your records as are subject to random audits.
