Licensee Requirements for Michigan Licensed Professional Counselors

Licensed professional counselors in the state of Michigan do not have any continuing education requirements in order to renew licenses, though, licenses do expire every three years. The responsibility is that of the licensee to ensure there are maintaining their knowledge in their field, ensuring their competence. Beyond that, the only requirement licensees have is to complete a one-time human trafficking training – required for all licenses that are being renewed after March 17, 2021. It's advised proof of completion is maintained via the received certificate for auditing purposes.
