

Continuing Education Requirements for New Jersey Marriage & Family Therapists (And How to Stay on Track)

As a licensed marriage and family therapist (MFT) in the state of New Jersey, it is your responsibility to adhere to continuing education requirements each period in order to renew your license. Beyond license renewal being key to you maintaining your practice, continuing education is essential to stay abreast of what is happening in your field – something your clients will always appreciate you taking seriously. Education is how we all continue to learn and further hone our skills and expertise, so it's certainly something to be celebrated. Though education is fantastic, keeping on track with the many hours you need to fulfill can be a challenge. Thankfully, there is a fantastic resource available to help you with that. Before we dive into the resource, let's start by outlining what is required of New Jersey MFTs in order to renew their license each year.

Licensee Requirements for California Marriage & Family Therapists

Licensed MFTs in New Jersey are required to complete 40 continuing education hours every two years from an American Psychological Association (APA)-approved entity. Approved courses are listed in N.J.A.C. 13:34-9.2 and 9.3, for reference. Of the 40 required hours for New Jersey MFTs, 20 hours can be earned online, while the other 20 must be earned live. Another requirement is that five hours must be related to ethics in marriage and family therapy, while another three must be regarding social and cultural competence. Given audits are conducted regularly, be sure to always maintain record of at least six years of continuing education in the event your credits are audited.
